Her Justice stands with women living in poverty in New York City by recruiting and mentoring volunteer lawyers to provide free legal help to address individual and systemic legal barriers.

2018 HIGHLIGHTS

Our 25th anniversary year has seen some wonderful milestones thanks to all of you— 4,636 women (vs. 3,466 last year) and 4,437 children received free services from 1,804 legal volunteers; we surpassed our goal at the Annual Photography Auction & Benefit; the Junior Advisory Board once again hosted a sold-out smash Red Party, and we conducted more community outreach than ever before.

We also launched a monthly newsletter, revamped our website, appeared in multiple media outlets, held Breakfast Briefings on timely issues featuring thought leaders in intersecting domains, and much more.

The headlines of this last year have been the news at Her Justice as well. Over a third of the women we helped came to us for immigration assistance. All of those clients are seeking safety from abuse in the United States. As the federal government made continuous changes last year to immigration law and policy, we had to re-evaluate many ongoing cases and field calls from volunteer lawyers worried about the impact of these changes on their clients.

When Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE) started arresting people in courthouses, it had a chilling effect on all of our foreignborn clients. Some clients chose to avoid the legal process altogether—too afraid of ICE to seek an order of protection against a batterer. So we joined a broad coalition of groups urging the NYS Court Administration to protect litigants from this form of intimidation.

Women living in poverty have faced historic discrimination in the legal system, often because they do not have a lawyer to help tell their stories. Child support cases are a particular challenge, with more than 90% of litigants going in front of judges alone. Without a lawyer, many clients would only receive the state-mandated minimum payment of just \$25 per month. So we launched a court-watching project to better understand how to improve the child support practices and policies impacting this vulnerable population.

Just as the #MeToo movement gives agency to women who have been victimized by men in power, the Her Justice 'Pro Bono First' model provides the clout of a private lawyer to women who would otherwise go unheard. To explore how #MeToo is impacting our profession, we partnered with Thomson Reuters this year to hold an ongoing series of roundtable conversations with leaders in the legal field.

A heartfelt thanks goes to all of our steadfast donors, supporters, volunteers, staff, Board members, Corporate Partners, and friends, without whom we could never accomplish so much. As we enter our second quarter of a century, do come with us as we continue to shift the power to the extraordinary and resilient clients we serve every day.

A partner at Willkie, Farr & Gallagher LLP, founder Cathy Douglass knew very little about domestic violence, but felt she needed to address an unmet need. With an initial \$75,000 in funding from Willkie, Network for Women's Services was incorporated in 1993 and Cathy embarked on the journey of a lifetime.



WHO WE SERVE



2018 CHILD SUPPORT COURT WATCHING PROJECT

Her Justice launched the Child Support Court Watching Project, in conjunction with the Fund for Modern Courts, to gather data and information about parents' experiences of Family Court. Child support is critically important to children and parents, particularly mothers: it lifts children out of poverty, and promotes fairness between parents in bearing the costs of raising their children. Yet parents often navigate the courts alone which makes it challenging to obtain fair child support awards. This project aims to shine a light on urgent issues of access to justice in the New York Family Court system which often are invisible even to lawyers and policy-makers.

This past year we conducted four trainings for law firm associates, law students, and other volunteers on the basics of child support and court watching. Volunteers observed more than 600 court proceedings, providing valuable insights that will form the basis of a report to be shared with court administrators. We hope that the report will encourage dialogue and action among lawyers and policy-makers aimed at improving outcomes for parents in child support cases in Family Court.





"What stands out for me was an early board meeting when a client came to speak about her experience with Her Justice.



HER JUSTICE IN THE COMMUNITY

To identify and assist women who would otherwise be isolated and underserved, Her Justice reached almost 500 individuals in diverse communities with 48 neighborhood events such as 'Know Your Rights' presentations, local information meetings, clinics, workshops and resource fairs about Her Justice services. These events brought much-needed legal information and resources relating to rights and remedies under immigration and family law to residents of all five boroughs of New York City (see map).



In 1995, Jacqueline (Jackie) Ekoumilong (R) showed up with her baby at the offices of Network for Women's Services. Jackie was the wife of a diplomat from Cameroon who had started seeing another woman and become abusive, withholding access to his salary and threatening to kidnap their son. Without any resources, Jackie turned to Network for Women's Services after being referred by a neighbor. Her volunteer attorney, Lynn Judell (L), took the courageous step of confronting the diplomat at the embassy and what ensued was somewhat of an international thriller. Jackie eventually became a U.S. citizen with sole custody of her son.
