Building Safer, Stronger Futures in New York City

A LETTER FROM OUR EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR & BOARD CHAIR

This year Her Justice celebrated 30 years of pursuing a New York City where women can rely on the civil justice system to deliver fair outcomes—so they can build safer, stronger futures for themselves and their families, free from abuse and defined, instead, by their own vision for their lives.

Since 1993, Her Justice has refined and elevated how pro bono can work. We've used our uniquely client-centered approach to level the playing field for over 45,000 women and children by providing free legal representation and advocating for smart policies that shift power into the hands of women like our clients. And we've deepened rich partnerships in the private, public, and government sectors that are key to our ability to be effective partners to women navigating our civil justice systems. Together over the last 30 years, we have provided 1.5 million hours of free legal services valued at over \$600 million to our clients and community!

Her Justice accomplished these remarkable results year after year. We did it by reimagining what access to justice looks like and adjusting how we provide services to our clients based on those ideas—for example, representing our divorce clients as they fight debt incurred through their partners' financial abuse. We're proud of the ways we've pushed our work forward over our 30-year history.


In FY23, we served 4,131 women and children—speaking 27 languages—across all five boroughs. 93% of our clients were women of color, 86% were survivors of intimate partner violence, 70% were mothers, and 51% needed an interpreter in court. **We did this through the power of pro bono, by training and mentoring 1,641 volunteer attorneys who partnered with our clients, donating just shy of 52,000 hours of service this year. This time is valued at \$43 million.** That's a huge investment in our communities and in changing our systems for the better—because inserting legal representation into our civil courts means individual clients fare better and the system's power, on the whole, tilts back towards people who need its solutions.

As we reflect on the last 30 years, we're also planning for the future. We believe a strong Her Justice experience—for clients, donors, partners, and staff—begins with a clear vision. Coming on the heels of deep cultural and economic change, this year was an opportune time for us to clearly identify areas of focus and growth for the organization, and we are excited to share more about that in this report.

As always, we remain proud of our team's commitment to excellence for clients, donors, partners, policymakers, peer organizations, and each other. In the face of the cultural, economic, and public health challenges that continue to impact our clients and communities, our team shows up every day focused on doing the work that builds towards Her Justice's vision for tomorrow.

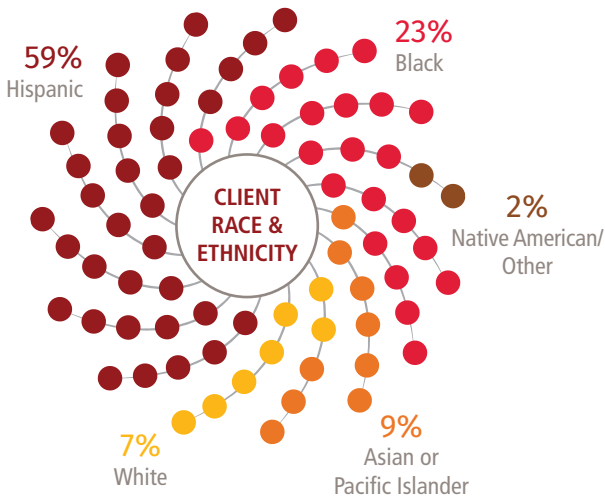
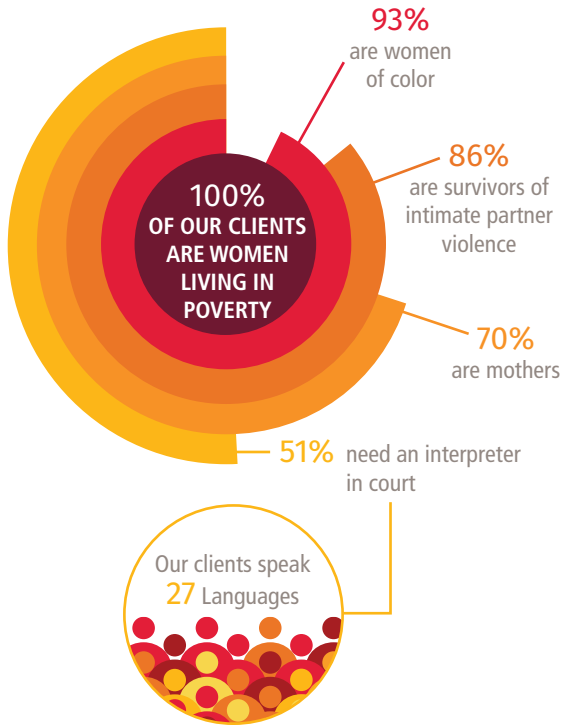

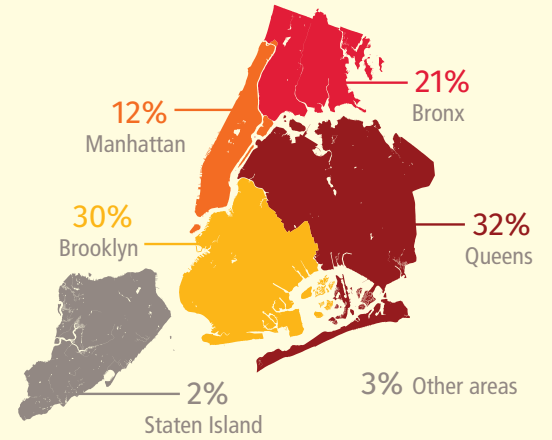

Advancing Our Policy Agenda

Our policy agenda is fueled by the lived experience of our clients. In FY 2023, Her Justice took over 40 policy actions to put power back in the hands of women like our clients and create a civil justice system that works better for all of us.

- **Testifying and submitting written testimony** for state and city hearings relating to gender equity, the need for robust legal services for low-income New Yorkers, and the modernization of New York courts in order to provide full access to justice.
- **Meeting with policymakers** to elevate issues affecting Her Justice clients and women experiencing poverty, including issues around child support and consumer protection for survivors of intimate partner violence.
- **Supporting federal, state, and city legislation** around gender equity, the rights of survivors of intimate partner violence, the rights of immigrants to a fair legal process and public benefits, and more.
- **Partnering with law firms on amicus briefs** in support of legal cases concerning the rights of immigrants and survivors of intimate partner violence.
- **Signing coalition letters** to federal and state policymakers supporting changes in policy to benefit immigrant survivors of gender-based violence, other immigrants, and women of color.

Planning a Stronger Future for Her Justice and Our Clients

AS WE LOOK BACK ON A POWERFUL 30 YEARS OF SERVICE, WE ALSO LOOK AHEAD TO WHAT'S NEXT

The pro bono field is at an important inflection point. In the last three years, there have been seismic changes in the world, our country, and the legal profession itself—all of which are interconnected and have led to a new pro bono landscape. From a shifting economy that has implications for both clients and firms; to changing federal and state laws that impact our clients' daily lives and the course of their cases; to evolving priorities and practices at legal firms—many pieces that have been historically fixed are now moving.

During this time of change, Her Justice is thinking strategically about what it means to maintain our status as a best-in-class pro bono provider. 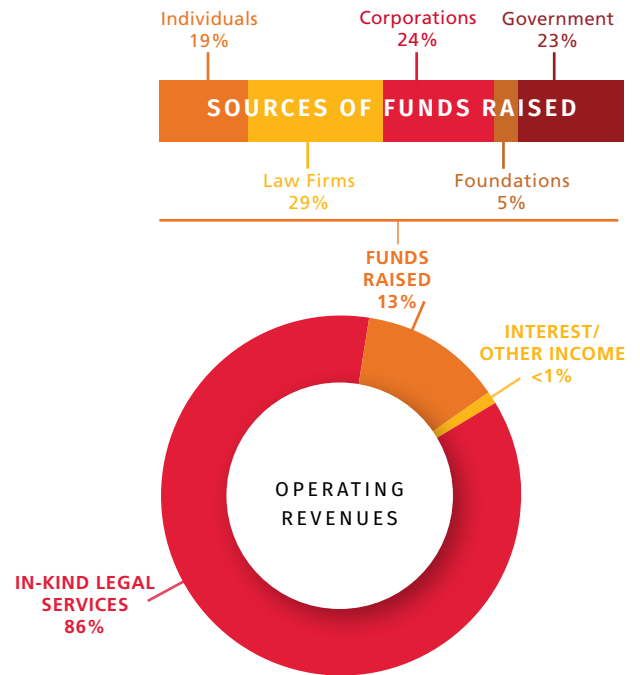

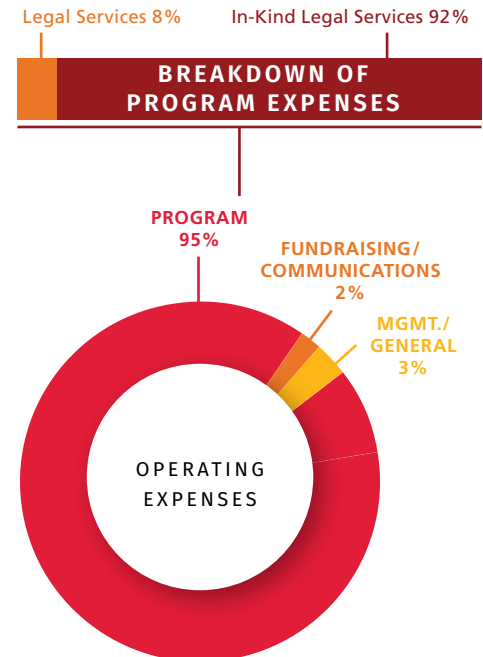
